Have your written Emergency Preparedness Plan Available!

IMPORTANT TIPS

- Have written procedures for ensuring children's safety and communication with parents;
- Identify a location to which children will be evacuated and reunited with their families;
- Have available important phone numbers, such as the local
 Office of Emergency Management (OEM) and parents;
- Have a fully stocked kit of emergency supplies (water, nonperishables and batteries)

OEM works closely with the state and county partners to prepare for hazards, natural or manmade, that could affect New Jersey's families, communities and businesses.

REMINDER – You must contact your <u>Child Care Resource and Referral Agency</u> if you need to change or schedule one of your emergency closing days.
