It is important to plan, prepare and be ready before a disaster takes place.
Have your written Emergency Preparedness Plan Available!

IMPORTANT TIPS

- Have written procedures for ensuring children's safety and communication with parents;
- Identify a location to which children will be evacuated and reunited with their families;
- Have available important phone numbers, such as the local Office of Emergency Management (OEM) and parents ;
- Have a fully stocked kit of emergency supplies (water, non-perishables and batteries)

OEM works closely with the state and county partners to prepare for hazards, natural or manmade, that could affect New Jersey's families, communities and businesses.

REMINDER – You must contact your [Child Care Resource and Referral Agency](#) if you need to change or schedule one of your emergency closing days.
